

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1 Mistreatment of dogs will not be allowed.
- 2 We have the right to dismiss any dog and or handler that threatens the safety of the instructors or other dogs or handlers. A refund will be given at the discretion of the instructor.
- 3 No smoking is allowed in the training building.
- 4 No alcohol or nonprescription drugs are allowed on the premises and handlers will not be allowed to train while intoxicated. You will be dismissed until the next class. More than one dismissal will result in expulsion from the training facility without a refund.
- 5 Dog training is an active physical sport, please dress appropriately with an understanding that bending, squatting , running are all part of training. Flat rubber soled shoes must be worn, no heeled shoes or boots unless medically necessary.
- 6 NO FLEAS. We reserve the right to expel any dog that has fleas. Upon the second warning, the dog will be dismissed without a refund.
- 7 Vaccinations and rabies must remain current during training.
- 8 No females in heat will be allowed in the beginner class. You will be allowed to sit in on classes without your dog . When the next session begins, you will be credited for the lost weeks. Please wash your dog after her cycle.
- 9 Do not allow your dogs to urinate on the building inside or out. If your dog has an accident, clean up supplies are available. Please exercise your pets in the designated areas and clean up after your pets.
- 10 We reserve the right to severely correct a dog that endangers the safety of others.
- 12 Only one handler is allowed to train the dog enrolled in class. No switching of handlers during the classes. It is very confusing for the dogs.
- 13 Families are welcome to come and watch, but please remain seated and quiet.
- 14 Service dogs will get a 50% discount off training prices with verification from organization.
- 15 Most importantly, you must have fun and enjoy yourself.
